WHAT IS JOC?

Job Order Contracting (JOC) is a construction delivery method used for repair, remodel and renovation projects through an alternative procurement strategy that allows a prequalified pool to procure and execute projects in a timely manner. This is a contract that the County will rebid in 2015 for a new two year contract.

If you are coming from I-90 take the Arlington Heights Rd exit and head north till Sigwalt St. The building is on the corner of Sigwalt and Arlington Heights Rd. If you pass E Northwest Hwy you've gone too far.

If you are coming from the east or west neighboring municipalities take Euclid or Palatine and turn on Arlington Heights Rd.

If you are coming from the south take 290 to hwy 53 to Euclid and then turn on Arlington Rd. When you arrive **park on the 3rd floor** of the parking structure, if you park on other floors there is the **possibility of getting a parking ticket**.

If your coming on 57th take exit 350 for 147th stand turn right on Dixie Hwy. Take Dixie Hwy just past 174th and the entrance will be on the left side of the street.

Brookfield Zoo Discovery Center

Brookfield Zoo is located at First Avenue between Ogden Avenue and 31st Street in Brookfield, Illinois, just 14 miles west of downtown Chicago. There are exits to First Avenue from the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) and from the Stevenson Expressway (I-55).

Signs on First Avenue will direct you to the South Lot. Take First Avenue to Ridgewood (just south of 31st Street). Turn west at the stoplight at Ridgewood, then follow that to Golf Road (first stop sign.) Turn north on Golf Road and proceed to the South Gate. Tell the parking attendants you are here for the County's Capital Planning meeting.
