requesting authorization for the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Homer Tree Service Inc., Lockport, Illinois as the lowest responsible bidder for Job Number 11-31-101.

This contract provides for the removal of three hundred and forty (340) trees that require stumping, three hundred and twenty nine (329) trees that do not require stumping, pruning of three (3) trees, and the removal of twelve (12) existing stumps at the Dan Ryan Forest Preserve sites. Homer Tree Service Inc. was the lowest of five (5) bidders.

The vast majority of trees to be removed have been impacted by the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). The District has been monitoring the spread of EAB since it was first found in Detroit, Michigan in 2002. The infestation in portions of the Forest Preserve District has reached the level where the District must take action to protect the users of the Preserves and the general public from potentially hazardous trees.

The Board of Commissioners of the Forest Preserve District approved the solicitation of bids on April 7, 2011. Sealed bids were received, opened and publicly read at the Bid Opening on May 5, 2011. The bids results were as follows:

- Homer Tree Service, Inc. \$88,904.00
- Groundskeeper Landscape \$126,500.00
- Alvarez \$148,629.00
- Galaxy \$148,642.50
- Clean Cut Tree Service, Inc. \$187,454.32

The Forest Preserve District of Cook County (“District”) staff requests approval to award a contract to Homer Tree Service Inc. and requests a waiver of Section 1-8-2(s) 5, to the extent that it is applicable, which requires successful bidders to submit evidence of participation in an active apprenticeship and training program. None of the bidders provided satisfactory documentation demonstrating participation in a United States Department of Labor (“DOL”) Office of Apprenticeship Program that is applicable to the work to be performed on this project. The Forest Preserve District staff is working with the DOL to design an apprenticeship program.

Homer Tree Service Inc. is in good standing with the State of Illinois.

The Forest Preserve District’s Chief Financial Officer has reviewed and approved the proposed expenditures.
